

# Determining Your Version of PowerTech Products

---

Use the following instructions to determine which version of a PowerTech product you are using. If you have any questions, please call PowerTech Technical Support.

## Authority Broker

1. Display the product main menu and enter the following command on a command line:

**LWRKAUTBKR**

2. From the menu that displays, select **option 5**, Configuration Menu.

3. On the next menu, select **option 21**, Product Version Information.

## Compliance Monitor

Compliance Monitor has three components. To determine the level of each individual component, do the following:

### **Consolidator**

Enter the following command on a command line:

**PTCMT2/LPRDVRM**

**Note:** The command also displays the version of the Web User Interface (WUI).

### **Endpoint**

Enter the following command on a command line:

**PTCMT3/LPRDVRM**

### **Web User Interface**

1. Enter the following to connect to the Consolidator system:

`http://sysname: 3035/ptcm`

where:

- *sysname* is the name of the system where the Consolidator is installed
- 3035 is the default port number used by Compliance Monitor

2. The version information displays on the Welcome tab.

**Note:** The Consolidator **PTCMT2/LPRDVRM** command also displays the version of the Web User Interface (WUI).

## **Network Security**

1. Display the product main menu and enter the following command on a command line:

**WRKPTNS**

2. Enter the following command to the display the version:

**LPRDVRM**

## **Interact**

1. Display the product main menu and enter the following command on a command line:

**DSPLIB PTINTERACT**

2. Verify whether the library PTINTERACT exists. If it does, you are using Interact 3.0.0. Otherwise, you are on a previous level.

## **DataThread**

Enter the following command on a command line:

**STRDT**

The version displays at the top of the DataThread menu.
